RESOLUTION NO. 2013-18

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF GARFIELD, WASHINGTON, WASHINGTON, declaring certain obsolete, unserviceable, and/or noncompliant shop equipment surplus and authorizing its disposal.

WHEREAS, the Town Council has determined that the A-frame 11-foot hoist in the town shop is obsolete and/or no longer serviceable, and/or no longer complies with L&I requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Town does not have the facilities to store this item and the Town Council has determined that it is surplus to the needs of the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has further determined that this item is unsafe for further use and, as such, is considered unmarketable and should be disposed of in such a manner that it cannot be used in the future, now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GARFIELD, WASHINGTON, that: the A-frame 11-foot hoist shall be and is hereby declared surplus to the needs of the Town and the public works department; and (b), the Mayor shall supervise the disposal of this item in such manner as the Mayor may, in his discretion, determine reasonable and appropriate, keeping in mind that the manner of disposal must be such that the item cannot be used in the future for hoisting purposes.
